In collaboration with other agencies and organizations, we provide a safe, stable and healthy environment that encourages, educates and empowers residents to become self-sufficient and productive members of our community and the larger society.

We deeply appreciate the many blessings that our local churches bestow on Simon House that improve the lives of families that we serve. Should you have a Sunday School Class or Youth Group that would want to take on a project to help these struggling families, we have a list of items that are needed at this time. These items include:

- *Children's and women's winter clothing all sizes, gently used or new.
- *Children's winter boots (we have sufficient shoes at this time from a generous donation)
- *Cleaning Supplies
- *Laundry Supplies
- *Baby Wipes
- *Size 5 diapers
- *Full sized shampoo, conditioner, antiperspirant, women's razors, personal hygiene items, bar soap, children's shampoo, baby lotion. Hotel sizes are nice, but don't last long.
- *Postage stamps
- *Copy Paper

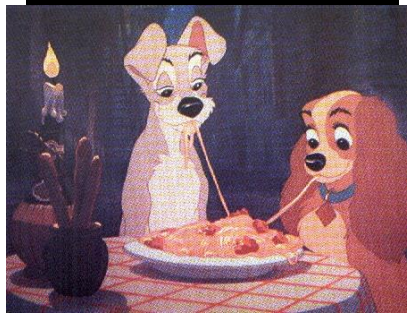
