What is a KID'S NIGHT OUT event?

KIDS NIGHT OUT (KNO) is a monthly event series put on by Immanuel Baptist Church that is exclusively for kids. These themed evenings give kids opportunities to create meaningful relationships with peers across Frankfort through community-building activities, arts and crafts, and structured play. Dinner is included and on-theme as well. KNO is purely a time of fellowship and fun; there will not be bible-based instruction at these events.

Who is eligible to participate?

For now, KNO is open to any child ages 3–12. Our nursery is also open during these events and can accomodate infants, as well as one and two year old siblings of eligible children. These spaces are limited, so timely registration is encouraged.

What is required to participate?

To participate in a KNO event, the legal guardian is required to fill out an online registration form before attending. On the night of, you'll complete a social media release form consenting to the use of your child's photo exclusively on our church's social media profiles; you can also opt-out. Finally, there is an in-person suggested donation of \$10 per child.

When is drop-off and pick-up?

Currently, KNO is open from 5 to 8 PM the last Friday of each month. Children may be dropped off between 5:00–5:30 PM. At 5:30 activities will begin, so we will not admit after that time. For pickup, authorized pick-up people can arrive between 7:30 and 8:00 PM.
